## Frog Hollow Round Robin/Open Play Format (Revised January 11, 2024):

Please do not enter the court until the start time of the Round Robin.

- When you arrive, the first four players will enter the court until there are 4 players on each court.
- The remaining players will line up their paddles on the floor in between the two tennis courts being used.
- Play one game to 11 (win by 2).
- The winning players stay on the court but split up. Losing players will put their paddle back in line with others waiting.
- After the initial game, win or lose you will only stay on the court for $\mathbf{2}$ more games.
- Once you have played 2 games, players will exit the court and put their paddle in line with the others waiting.
- Players who are staying on for their second game will split up and become opponents
- The players whose paddles are next in line will enter the open court.

The spirit of Open Play is that everyone gets to play with different players in a recreational and fun setting. The objective of Open Play is to have people learn from playing with others. There is no rearranging of paddles so that people stick together. If there are specific players you want to play with, then you can rent a court to do so.

Please don't walk onto courts when tennis is being played. Please walk behind the curtains to get to your pickleball court.
